Principal's Report:

- Thank you to the PTA for all that you have done since last Spring!
- Enrollment 868

- Teachers took advantage of all the classes offered by the county in preparation for the virtual start
- Brought in some excellent teachers this year (5 new teachers)
- Encouraged parents to speak with teachers if something isn't working
- Curriculum grade level teams are stronger than they've ever been
- ADA renovations took place in the building (lowering rails, placing up signs in braille, ripped up sidewalks and replaced with ramps, slope of sidewalks were made more wheelchair friendly)
- Q&A with Principal Phillips:
- Thoughts were shared about Dr. Gloria's talk with City Council
- 10/26 is return date for Special Education students to return to in-school instruction
- Supporting the Return to School Group run through Fairfax County Office for Children group of children (estimate 60 kids) are not receiving in-school instruction, but attend virtual school at PES.
- Fairfax County is trying to make plans about how to handle what will come next.
- Several School Board Meeting this month
- Prior to going virtual, teachers had a few options to apply for 1) Leave of Absence 2) Resign or Retire 3) Get Doctor's letter stating it's not safe to teach in the building due to health reasons. They could also share if they had issues with childcare or a family member that is high risk.
- Discussion regarding BBCU vs. Google Meet and which works best for student/teacher meetings.

Treasurer's Report:

- We had to cut a lot of things this year or limit it, since we are assuming that fundraising will be a lot less due to not being able to hold in-person events
- Cash on hand = \$15,850
- We took some funds from grade-level and special teachers funds as they usually go towards field trips and in-school activities
- Still expecting to hold Read-a-thon and Book Fair and hopeful that they will do well
- A .pdf of the budget is available
- We've ramped up our Membership push this year and provided line items for donations for activities on Mondays, Principal's Fund, Staff & Teacher Appreciation.
- We increased the Staff & Teacher Appreciation Fund this year.
- We offered teachers a choice of 4 different gift cards (Total Wine, Starbucks, Dunkin Donuts, and High Side) since we can't host special in-school gifts as we have in the past.
- 2019-2020 Audit will be sent out to all PTA members for review
