- Vandalism Incident update: Investigation underway, similar to possible social media prank seen at KJMS, Vandalism was a threatening message defacing property in a bathroom found @ 4:15 on Thursday 2/23
 - Parents can help by monitoring children's access and use of social media.
 - Students should report any information they have to a trusted school adult.
 - Teachers are monitoring all bathroom usage at this time.
 - Letters to the community are handled by FCPS overseeing administration and their communication office
 - Police are and FCPS are involved in the investigation and an increased police and SRO presence in the school should be expected during investigation
 - Custodians clean every day, they see what they see-but may miss vandalism
 - Lockdown procedure—If an incident occurs, the school will be on lockdown and all communication would come from outside authorities (police, FCPS) Do not encourage cellphone use by students which could impede the police's procedures in an incident
 - SRO are not always in buildings unless called in, Our ARO is based in KJMS, but are quick to respond. Police mentors are regular visitors and come quickly when needed, security generally has a presence but not constant. During investigation School security will be more constant
