

Grades 1-6 visit the fair during the school day at the beginning of the week. Parents can send in money with their students to purchase books or use the online wallet provided by Scholastic. We also invite the entire family to attend our family nights, or parents are welcome to come in during school hours and browse the selections as well.

CHESS CLUB

Playing chess is a great way to develop a child's critical thinking skills, sportsmanship and patience — all while having fun!

Students will learn to code their own interactive animations, stories and games using Scratch.

Scratch is a fun and creative way to learn programming skills and computational thinking.

FUNDRAISING

The PTA runs events throughout the year to raise funds. These events typically include a fall fundraiser (Read-A-Thon) and a spring fundraiser (Fun Run/Spring Fling event), as well as Family Nights Outs and other activities that are listed separately within this glossary.

GIRLS ON THE RUN (GOTR)

This is an after-school program (grades 3-6 only) offered in the fall/spring which teaches life skills through dynamic lessons and running games. Certified GOTR coaches (also teachers at PES) teach the curriculum. GOTR programs across Northern Virginia participate in a 5K race at the end of their season. Runners of all ages and abilities are welcome and invited to register for the 5K, even those that do not participate in GOTR during the year.



KISS & RIDE

OLDEST AND ONLY

OUTDOOR
MOVIE NIGHT

A dedicated area at the side of the school for students being dropped off and picked up during arrival and dismissal. Please review the Kiss & Ride policies with your children and all potential drivers to avoid confusion. The safety of our children is our primary goal. If all drivers cooperate, we can accomplish a safe and efficient Kiss & Ride process.

When the school or PTA sends home information in a Tuesday folder it sometimes goes to every child. When possible, we use an "oldest and only" distribution list to avoid having parents receive duplicates. This means the oldest child in the family or an only child will receive the flyer.

Bring your blanket and beach chairs, sit back and enjoy the show. This is a free family-friendly event. Popcorn and concessions will be available for purchase and food trucks will be present. This is typically held in late September/October.



PANTHER DANCE

A school-wide favorite – join us for a night of dancing and fun! Held in April, this is a night the entire family looks forward to and it's one of our most popular events! Music and games with a DJ, dancing for everyone, and popcorn and other concession available.

PTA MEETINGS

The PTA hosts meetings for parents and teachers with paid PTA membership in order to communicate information regarding past and future PTA events and business. School updates are provided by administration, teachers, PTA committee chairs and PTA officers. Meetings last about 60 minutes. The PTA tries to alternate meetings during the day and evening to encourage all to attend. Meetings may also be paired with guest speakers. Information regarding PTA meetings and presenters are communicated in the Tuesday folder.



PTA MEMBERSHIP

Everyone — parents, educators, students and other citizens active in their schools and communities — is invited to join our not-for-profit parent association. You may join at any time during the year, but we encourage you to sign up early to maximize the benefits.

READ-A-THON


SCHOOL SUPPLIES

A three-week, school wide program that focuses entirely on reading. This is the PTA's largest fundraising activity of the school year, and it is organized and managed by the PTA. SIXTH GRADE PARTY

The SCA is a group of student leaders who work with an adult advisor to collaborate with others to impact their school community, which impacts their city or town, which impacts our state, which impacts our country, which changes the world. Elections are held for graders 3-6 for class representatives.

Ouy Sixth Graders have worked hard for 7 years at PES, and they deserve a day of fun! The last day of school is a party, just for the graduates. The party is planned, organized and hosted by 6th grade parents on a volunteer basis. It is preceded by the 6th grade parade, where the 6th graders walk through the hallways of Providence while being cheered on by the younger grade students and teachers. It features a secret theme voted and decided upon by the parents. Past 6th grade parties have featured food, a DJ, games and a photo booth. It's a special event in which the 6th graders are given a big send off as they leave PES and head to middle school. Donations are needed to pay for this event, and parents will be contacted during the year



STEAM LAB AND STEAM NIGHT PES uses a dedicated lab space and two STEAM resource teachers to cycle all students through three to four engineering challenges during the year. The challenges require five consecutive days for each class, which allows students to understand the challenge, take it through the engineering design process to collaboratively find solutions, collect and share data, improve designs, and reflect on how they used their Innovator Skills. A family STEAM night is held during the school year where you can be hands-on with your child, using these Innovator Skills.

STRINGS

PES students are invited to join Strings (grades 4-6) or Band (grades 5-6). This is a great opportunity for your child to try out different instruments.



TEACHER APPRECIATION WEEK

In recognition of the hard work of our classroom teachers, instructional assistants and specialists, the PTA organizes a week of activities to show them our gratitude. Detailed information is sent home in Tuesday Folders and posted online prior to this week. Students and families can celebrate and contribute individually throughout the week. Teacher Appreciation Week is celebrated in the spring.

TEARS AND CHEERS

There's no better way to dry those tears as you leave your kindergartener's classroom than meeting other parents experiencing the same emotions you are. Join us for a little snack, coffee and conversation for an opportunity to meet some of our administrators and PTA volunteers.
